

100 new jobs as finance firm expands

A LEADING finance firm is to create 100 jobs in Glasgow with a move to new offices.

Telephone and online mortgage broker Moneyquest is shifting from its present headquarters in West George Street to 123 St Vincent Street.

The move, at the end of next month, will allow the company to expand its staff to 240.

It aims to become the UK's biggest firm in its sector.

The firm, which handled £1.1 billion of mortgage business last year from its Glasgow and Edinburgh offices, has now launched a recruitment drive.

The two-year expansion plan also includes a target of increasing mortgage business to £3bn.

Operations director Paul Reynolds said: "At present, the 140 staff across our offices in Glasgow and Edinburgh are

receiving more inquiries than they are able to process.

"It is essential we boost staff numbers to increase productivity and improve the services.

"We felt 123 St Vincent Street was the place for us as it occupies a strategic position close to our current location and will meet our future expansion plans."
